## IMPORTANT Notes for 2011:

1. Please DO NOT add vehicles to your entry without telling us. It upsets the line-up for others. We must know in advance approximately how many feet to allow for each group.
  2. Please be aware of the height of your entry and remember that there are some low wires across the road on the parade route. NO ENTRIES may be OVER 13 feet HIGH!! If you knock down a wire, it will be your liability, not the Business & Professional Association's.
  3. Children running into the road to catch candy thrown to them is a SERIOUS SAFETY CONCERN. If you plan to provide candy or other crowd give-aways, please bring walkers who can hand this out safely from either side of your parade entry instead of throwing it from a float, etc.
  4. NO ICE POPS! They cause a big sticky mess on the roadway.
  5. You will be notified EXACTLY WHERE your members should go to line up at the BH-BL High School OR at the Burnt Hills Lanes, but please WARN ALL MARCHERS in advance that they should plan to arrive before 6:30 on June 9.
- \* Anyone marching with a horse or other animal MUST also provide a person on pooper-scooper patrol for the safety and courtesy of those marching behind them.
